PINACLES is to offered SNAP recipients (18+) through a partnership with the New York City Department of Human Resources Administration, the New York State Department of Social Services, and Kelm Academy. It is a career, talent, and professional development program for enhancing workforce skills. Using the 5-STEP Career Development Model, participants demonstrate substantial knowledge of self, establish career paths, identify academic and career opportunities, and make informed and meaningful career decisions.



COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

HEPA Purifiers - We use HEPA grade air filters which can theoretically remove at least 99.97% of dust, pollen, mold, bacteria, and any airborne particles with a size of 0.3 microns, including the virus that causes COVID-19.



UV Light – We use lightbulbs designed to kill viruses, bacteria, or mold spores floating around by exposing them to ultraviolet light.

Hybrid Classes – The use of distance education supports social distancing rules. Half of the students participate on campus, while the other half participate in live online classes on alternating days.

Social Distancing Policy - All students must be fully vaccinated with the booster shots and follow the rules of New York concerning social distancing. We require that everyone wears masks in the classroom at all times.
